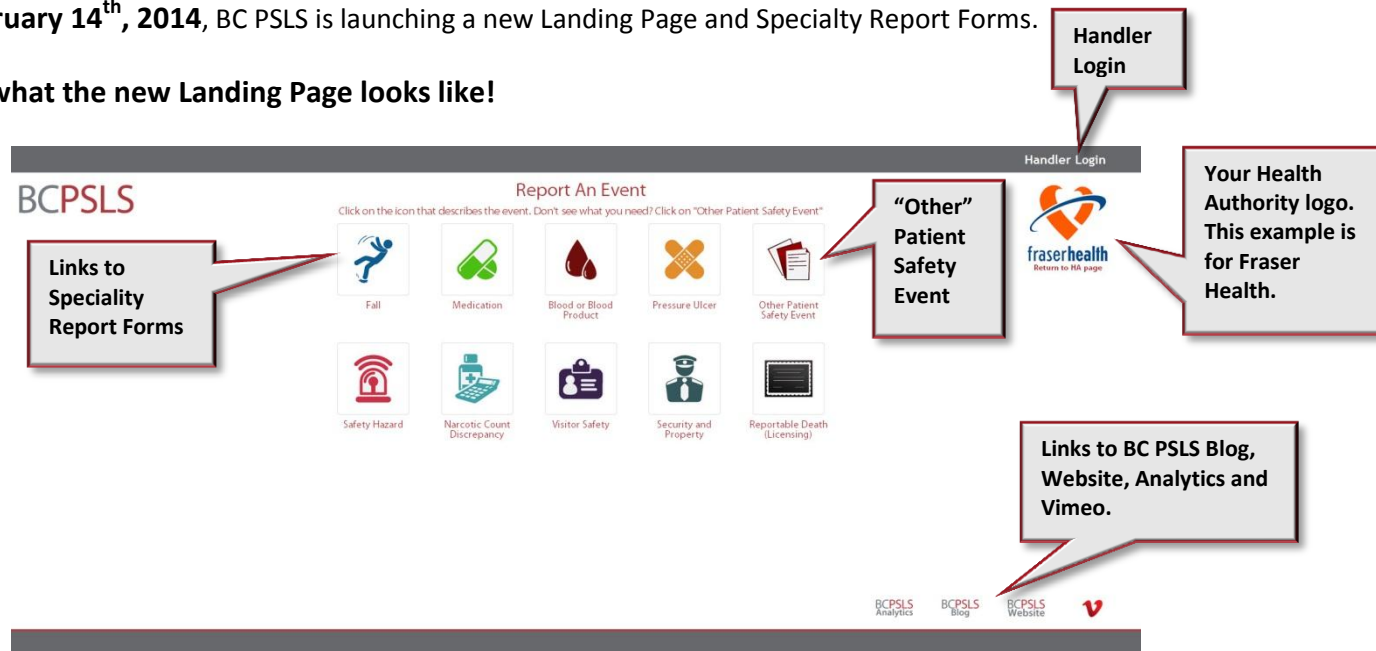


## What is changing?

On February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014, BC PSLs is launching a new Landing Page and Specialty Report Forms.

This is what the new Landing Page looks like!



## What do I need to know?

- **Reporters will access** the new Landing Page and Specialty Report Forms **the same way as before.**
- **Reporters** should now select one of the Specialty Report Forms to report safety events whenever possible. For example, to report a **“Fall”** involving a patient, client or resident, Reporters should click on the **“Fall”** icon. **Tip!** For events that don't fit with any icon, the **“Other Patient Safety Event”** icon should be chosen and the general Health Authority report form will be used.
- **Handlers** should follow the link from their Health Authority webpage to find the follow-up form as usual. **Tip!** The follow-up form may also be accessed by clicking **“Handler Login”** on the new Landing Page.

## Why is this change happening?

The new Landing Page will offer a more intuitive way for Reporters to select the correct event category, and the targeted questions and clearer language used on the Specialty Report Forms will help Reporters to provide just the right information. Data quality and consistency will both be improved, resulting in better information to support learning from safety events. Wherever possible, forms have been made shorter, so time to complete reports should be decreased as well.
